



Cabernet Sauvignon 2009

Variety: 85% Cabernet Sauvignon / 15% Syrah.

Origin: D.O. Marchigüe - Colchagua Valley.

Soil: Soft hillocks of granitic origin, average depth and clay loam texture. Moderate humidity retention, with low organic material.

Climate: Mediterranean with wide temperature range. Its proximity to the Pacific Ocean creates a moderate marine influence. This gives as a result, a low ripening process, obtaining more complex grapes.

Aging: In French oak barrels for 12 months.

Alcohol: 14,5%

PH: 3,35

Winemaker's Notes:

This brilliant ruby red Cabernet Sauvignon shows red fruit aromas with chocolate and tobacco notes. With soft but firm tannins, this fresh wine presents a nice body with a balanced and persistent finish.
